

# BE A SUPER HERO WITH CADA LEADERSHIP - 2011

## THE 2011 CADA/CASL HIGH SCHOOL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The CADA/CASL organizations have put together an exciting and informative Summer Leadership Camp Program designed to improve your skills, provide hands on training, increase your awareness, and alert you to various responsibilities. To ensure that you will benefit the most from the CADA/CASL Leadership Program we have included some information on activities and items to bring to camp.

1. Please **carefully** complete the 3-part registration form. Be sure to complete all parts and obtain all signatures required. *You cannot participate in camp until this form is completely filled out.* Return TWO COPIES (BRING THE PINK TO CAMP) by June 10, 2011. Completed registration forms must be returned postmarked no later than June 10. **Late** registration forms must be confirmed by telephone (after June 10) to ensure that your camper's place (and fees) will not be lost to campers on our waiting list. **THANKS!**
2. Cars will not be permitted. Students must ride to camp with their advisor, parents, or come by bus/train/plane. Students who bring cars will not be allowed to register, and will forfeit all camp fees.
3. Students who are coming to camp by bus/train/plane must advise us. At U.C. Santa Barbara, shuttle service will be again provided through CADA Leadership camps, only on the first and last days of camp. Please book the train to and from the NEW Goleta Station. We will **NOT** pick up from the Santa Barbara Station. **This service is free this year, but you must reserve Shuttle spaces ahead of time.**
4. All medications must be listed on the medical information sheet and checked in at registration.
5. Students who use or possess drugs, liquor, tobacco in any form, or other items not usually allowed at schools will be sent home by common carrier at the parent's expense or detained until they can be picked up by a parent or school official, and will forfeit all camp fees. **Please note that certain other rule infractions may justify these consequences.**
6. **Registration time is 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.** on the first day of camp. Please plan to arrive by 12:30 so that we will have adequate time to register you before the **first session at 2:00 p.m.**
7. The **first meal at camp will be lunch on the first day of camp during registration.** There will be 3 meals served per day except for the last day.
8. Camp activities will **end about 12:00 p.m. (noon) the last day.** Please schedule transportation to leave after that time and allow as much time as possible to get you to the train, plane, or bus connection. That is usually hectic time and the more time we have the better we can serve you.
9. **All registration forms with emergency information should be returned by June 10, 2011.** If forms are not received by that time the camp fees will be forfeited and the space opened up to other campers. Be sure the medical information is complete as a student will not be able to register until this important requirement is done. Be sure to list accurate emergency contact information.
10. Each camper must give a room key deposit at the time of registration at camp. This deposit will be returned at the end of camp when the key is returned. Please use the enclosed envelope to **bring your key deposit to camp in.** A check made out to CADA Leadership Camps is the safest way to accomplish this. **DO NOT MAIL KEY DEPOSITS... BRING THEM TO CAMP.**
11. Students may want to bring a little extra money to camp. **Snack items and camp shirts** will be available at the camp store and there is a university bookstore on campus with other necessary items.
12. If your travel plans change from what is listed on the registration form you must call CADA Leadership at (530) 383-3500 or (530) 662-8533 (message), (530) 662-8118 (fax) and advise us of the changes. E-mail: jziggie@aol.com
13. Specific directions to camp will be included with the letter from each site director about one week before that particular camp.
14. School posters, banners, signs, and door decorations are fun! If you do happen to bring decorations please don't hang them outside the buildings. All material must be removed before check out is complete. At UCSB decorations must be confined inside your sleeping room.
15. Dress is casual for CADA/CASL Leadership Camps. **But remember you are leaders so please make sure your camp clothing is appropriate following your school's dress code.** It does get chilly in the evenings so a sweat shirt or jacket would help.
16. Other significant items - "The Fun Stuff"
  - a. There will be a camp talent show at the 3 high school camps only. Bring whatever you will need to perform.
  - b. Our Dress Up Days for 2011. Day One - School Shirts. Day Two - CADA Camp Shirt. Day Three - Super Hero Day. Day Four - Your Choice.
  - c. Bring your watch, alarm clock, a writing instrument, and your positive attitude.
